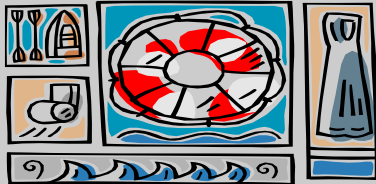

November sees a busy time at Port Campbell Holiday Park with the arrival of our new 2 bedroom cabins and lodgings. Our amenities will be getting a refurbishment ready for the summer rush.

FISHING

The experience of fishing the shipwreck coast not only includes the actual fishing but the chance to enjoy the unique spectacular formations of the area and the history of the many sailing ships that came to grief on the coast line such as the "Loch Ard" and the "Schomberg".

Bream is being caught in local estuaries including the Curdies, Gellibrand and Hopkins rivers. Salmon up to 3.5kg are being caught off Clifton and Princetown beaches with whitebait, blue bait and surf poppers.

When fishing in Port Campbell you will need a fishing licence, you should know your catch size, limits and let someone know where you are going fishing and your expected time of return. For all equipment, bait, licences and fishing information including hotspots and local knowledge, see the team at Port Campbell

There are many places to test your taste buds in Port Campbell and they are all on the main strip, 2 mins from the park.

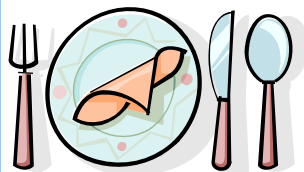
If you like gourmet pizza you will love Nicos Pizza & Pasta.

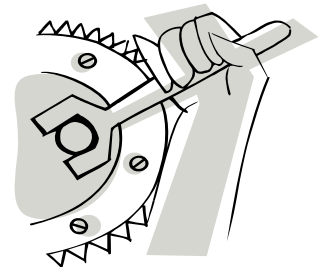
