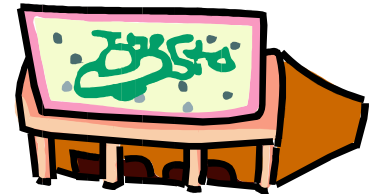
What's been happening??
